This guide is for learners and staff using the college Wi-Fi, eduroam

Eduroam is a Wi-Fi service available to learners and staff of Colleges and Universities around the world. Using your RHACC email address, you can connect your phone, laptop or other device to the eduroam Wi-Fi network and use it for free. Please remember that, as with any College IT facility, you must keep to our IT Acceptable Use Policy which is on the College Website https://www.rhacc.ac.uk/about-us/policies-and-reports. There are also special conditions for eduroam https://www.rhacc.ac.uk/eduroamuk-policy

These instructions cover most devices. Please check the section 'Before you start' first, and then work through the section that relates to your own device. If your device type is not listed, please contact IT Services for help.

!!! You must set up eduroam every time you change your college email password !!!

As always, if you have problems connecting, please log a ticket on the helpdesk or for Learners only, the RHACC Learner IT Helpdesk.

1 Before you start

There are **four** things to do before you connect:

1 Make sure you have an internet connection.

You can use your own mobile data plan or the **Events & Hires** (password – *setup7941*) network if you are in the College.

Remember to 'forget' **Events & Hires** network when you've finished.

2 Your device must have a passcode or pin to use eduroam.

If you don't have one, set one up using your device's security settings.

3 Make sure you know your college email address and college computer password

For learners - your email address is your studentID@students.rhacc.ac.uk

EG.: If your student number is 12345678 then your email address is 12345678@students.rhacc.ac.uk

Your password is your date of birth in *DDMMYYYY* format.

EG.: If your date of birth is 12 November 1996, your password is 12111996


2 Android

2.1 Check your Android version

Open the Settings app. Its normally, a gear like this Near the bottom of the list tap 'About Phone/Device', then 'Android version'.

2.2 Android 8 and later

This will cover most Android devices which are less than 4 years old.

2.3 **Android 4.3 to 7**

For Android 4.3 to 7 you should use the 'eduroam CAT' application, downloadable for free from the PlayStore

Download and install the eduroam CAT app from the Play Store using the app on your phone

2 Run the app and give it the permissions it asks for

Follow the instructions

It will ask you to select a 'Nearby Config'. Select Richmond and Hillcroft Adult Community College or do a Manual Search for it.

Confirm that you wish to install.

Enter your college username and password

Continue to confirm everything, until you see a message saying


'Status: CONNECTED to SSID "eduroam.




